## Recipe File ...

### Adored Lemon Cake

120g Butter  
180g SR Flour  
2 Eggs  
1/2 Cup Milk  
2 Lemons—zest and Juice  
Extra 2 Tablespoons Sugar

#### Method:

1. Preheat oven to 180oC.
2. Cream Butter and Sugar.
3. Add Flour, Eggs & Milk.
4. Beat well.
5. Pour into a lined loaf tray.
6. Bake for 1 hour.
7. To make syrup, heat lemon juice and extra sugar until dissolved.
8. When cooked, pour over syrup.
