Frozen Christmas Pudding ...

1/2 Cup Sultanas
1/2 Cup chopped Raisins
1/4 Cup Brandy
600ml Cream
200g Condensed Milk
150g Dark Cooking Chocolate, melted
1/4 teaspoon Cinnamon
1/4 teaspoon Nutmeg
100g Glace Cherries, chopped
50g Flaked Almonds

Method:

1. Soak the sultanas and raisins in the brandy overnight.
2. Lightly whip the cream. Stand for 15 minutes to bring to room temperature.
3. Add the condensed milk, then the melted chocolate and stir together quickly but thoroughly.
1. Stir in the spices, soaked fruit, cherries and nuts. Freeze for a minimum of 8 hours.
2. Serve whole or scooped into individual bowls.
