

HEIA(SA) Inc: The Resek Scholarship

A generous donation to honour the contribution made by Misses Ellen and Marietta Resek to Home Economics has enabled the establishment of the Resek Scholarship. The purpose of this award is to encourage undergraduate training of home economics and to provide financial support to a student enrolled on either a full-time or part-time basis.

The Resek Scholarship is available to undergraduate students of a South Australian tertiary institution enrolled in the second year or later of a Home Economics course.

Subject to the availability of funds there will be one annual award to the total of \$1,000 based on a full-time load or proportionately reduced for a part-time load.

The Resek Scholarship Rules

This is an award established by the Home Economics Institute of Australia (South Australia) Inc to be known as "The Resek Scholarship" The purpose of the award is to provide financial support to an undergraduate student enrolled in the second or later year of their course. Subject to the availability of funds there will be one annual award to a total of \$1,000 based on a full-time load, or proportionately reduced for a part-time load.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants for the scholarship must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident of Australia; and normally reside in South Australia and be enrolled in an undergraduate course of a South Australian tertiary institution; and have successfully completed the first year requirements of an undergraduate degree of the tertiary institution.

TENURE: The award is awarded for one full-time year of study or proportionately reduced for part-time study, subject to the award holder maintaining their enrolment, and satisfactory academic performance. Award payments will be withdrawn if the award holder withdraws or is precluded from the course. The award will be paid in equal instalments at the beginning of each semester.

SOURCE OF FUNDS: The Resek Scholarship will be funded from a donation made by Ellen and Marietta Resek. The award will continue as long as donations and earnings thereon are sufficient.

SELECTION: The award will be awarded on the basis of a demonstrated academic merit. Selection will be made by a Selection Committee which shall comprise the President, Treasurer and two members of the executive of HEIA(SA) Inc.

PRESENTATION: The award will be presented to the recipient at the World Home Economics Day Function which is held in March each year.
