Program Prerequisites

Program Fees

Standard program fees: \$5,890

Through the National Excellence in School Leadership Initiative, a full scholarship of \$5,890 will be awarded to one HEIA member at the 2017 National Conference. Funding for Australia's female school leaders

Female school leaders funding is the result of NESLI's commitment to supporting the increased representation of women in formal school leadership positions. Over the 2017 year, NESLI will allocate scholarship funding to schools across Australia to enable high potential female staff to participate in the internationally recognised Advanced Leadership Program (ALP).

Scholarships are available. Scholarships will be awarded on merit through a written application process. Some applicants will be required to pay a balance of fees to undertake the program.

The Advanced Leadership Program offers a timely forum for female school leaders to connect on a regular basis and share vital information. By offering a forum exclusively reserved for female leaders the ALP creates a space to discuss current challenges and consider important issues surrounding the future of school leadership.

Developed in partnership with Women & Leadership Australia (the country's foremost authority on women's leadership), the ALP is informed and guided by unprecedented collaboration between education sector stakeholders and leading Australian universities.

Run in convenient bite-size modules over an extended six month period the ALP is designed to align with participants existing schedules and commitments and have minimal impact on day to day school operations.
